

Wooden Clothespin Pilgrim Tutorial

- Print the provided pattern for the clothes pieces
- Gather all of your supplies. You will need:
 - Wooden clothespins
 - Black fabric
 - White fabric
 - Thin white ribbon
 - White pipe cleaners
 - Black permanent marker
 - Gold glitter or paint
- Cut out the fabric using pinking shears (this will help keep the edges of the material from fraying)

To Make the Girl Pilgrim

- Wrap the pipe cleaner with the fabric for the “sleeves”, hot glue to secure.
- Add white ribbon around the edge of the sleeves for added detail.
- Hot glue the pipe cleaner arms to the middle back of the wooden clothespin
- Wrap the dress around the front, making sure to wrap around the arms and secure with hot glue.
- Wrap the collar around the neck (just below the round part of the clothes pin) and secure with glue
- Place the white apron on top of the black skirt and slightly bunch it together. Add a small dab of hot glue to each side and secure to dress. Finally tie the small white ribbon around the waist to keep the apron in place.
- Add the bonnet to the top of the head, trim if necessary.
- Use a permanent marker to draw the black boots on the feet
- Add a face using permanent marker and colored pencils.

To Make the Boy Pilgrim

- Wrap the pipe cleaner with the fabric for the “sleeves”, hot glue to secure.
- Wrap each “leg” with the pants and secure with hot glue.
- Wrap the Jacket around the body and secure with fabric belt and hot glue.
- Hot glue the pipe cleaner arms to the middle back of the wooden clothespin
- Wrap the collar around the neck (just below the round part of the clothes pin) and secure with glue
- To make the hat, wrap the top part of the pattern around and secure with hot glue. Glue to the bottom part of the hat (the round part.) Stuff the inside with scraps of fabric or tissue paper to help keep its shape. Cut a small circle to close up the top of the hat and glue it to the top.
- Hot glue the hat to the top of the wooden clothespin
- Use a permanent marker to draw the black boots on the feet
- Add a face using permanent marker and colored pencils.
- Use glitter paint to draw buckles on the hat and belt.
